#### The GenWell Project to End Social Isolation

**Peter Bombacci**, the dynamic man who made **Movember** such a powerful movement in Canada, recently founded <u>The GenWell Project</u>.

As their website explains, "The GenWell Project is a campaign whose mission is to make the world a happier and healthier place by reminding people about the importance of face to face social connection and inspiring them to take action."

We know that members of our group are increasingly encountering serious loneliness due to their cancer, other illnesses and the deaths of their loved ones. GenWell could open new avenues for communication and friendship that could extend lives and make them happier.

The GenWell Project offers ideas and guidance for those willing to hold events to "decrease social isolation through increased social interaction" or more simply "get out there" and get to know more people in the community to their mutual benefit. Event size does not matter; it can be something as simple as having coffee with a neighbour or a picnic in a park or a neighbourhood potluck. Events for kids could be anything from a game of tag to a night at a Go Kart track. All can be registered with the Project and be eligible for prizes from major sponsor **President's Choice**.

The next **GenWell Weekend** is **September 14 through 16**, a bit too late for us to get anything organized, but please take a look and consider getting involved.


